By this point I am sure that we are all aware of the Coronavirus and its effects on the world. The best way to protect ourselves is to be proactive. This means doing our best to prevent the transmission and spread of the virus. The number one most important thing we can do is to practice good hand hygiene. Wash, wash and wash again! Please speak to your children about this daily. Hand sanitizer works against this virus and is in each classroom as well. If your child is sick, I ask that you keep them home for as long as needed until they are recovered. We can always send work home.

Finally, I wanted to let you know that I have been in constant contact with the County and State health departments and we have developed a task force at the school to address any and all concerns regarding this virus. Lastly, be prepared, should you travel to any high risk areas or experience exposure to the virus to be asked to self-quarantine for 14 days.
